To whom it may concern,

I have had the opportunity to get to know Mike Katz over the past several years, and I want to speak plainly about why I believe he is prepared to represent Delaware in the United States Senate.

Mike is not someone who approaches this lightly. He has taken the time to understand people, to listen, and to engage in conversations that matter. His decision to step forward is grounded in a belief that public service still means something and that this moment calls for people willing to take responsibility. That matters.

Mike's background is not theoretical. It is lived. Over the course of more than two decades as an anesthesiologist and pediatric critical care specialist, he has cared for tens of thousands of patients, from newborns to seniors, in some of the most critical moments of their lives.

I see it as someone who has taken the time to think critically, to engage with different perspectives, and to ultimately align with the principles he believes are right. That kind of clarity comes from experience and from being willing to make a decision with intention. **And when you step back and look at it, it fits exactly who he is.**

Mike approaches problems the way a physician does. You assess honestly. You do not ignore symptoms. You do not treat around the issue. You identify what is actually going on and you take action to address it. In his time in public service, that meant pushing for transparency, accountability, and reforms that put people over politics.

As former Sussex County Chair and now Vice Chair of the Delaware Republican Party, I have had the chance to see what leadership looks like at the local and state level. It requires consistency, discipline, and the ability to carry responsibility on behalf of others. Mike brings those qualities forward in a way that is steady and real.

This race is about more than rhetoric. It is about who is prepared to do the job.

Mike Katz has spent his life in positions where the margin for error is zero and the responsibility is real. He understands what it means to be accountable for outcomes, not just words.
